

Gwyn Ashton is releasing a brand new contemporary electric swamp rock blues album in 2024 titled "Grease Bucket".

The newly-formed *Gwyn Ashton Group* consists of Italian bassist and harmonica player *Fabio Drusin* and British drummer *Chris Sharley*. This dynamite trio has been smashing stages across Germany in 2023 in preparation for the album release.

One of Europe's top bassists, *Drusin* has been touring with Memphis bluesman *Alvin Youngblood Hart* and spotted onstage numerous times with *Gov't Mule* and *ZZ Top's Billy Gibbons*. *Sharley* from '70s iconic band *Sassafras* and *Mick Clarke Band* completes the lineup. This powerhouse rhythm section complements *Ashton* well, supplying the perfect rock-solid foundation with three-part vocal harmonies and plenty of jamming through the songs that change shape every night, keeping it fresh for each show.

Grease Bucket is Gwyn Ashton's grooviest album to date, his songwriting continually developing, allowing him to carve out his own voice with a refreshingly new take on the "modern retro" swamp rock blues formula and will be released early 2024.

Formerly with Virgin Records, Gwyn Ashton was once lead guitarist in Europe with Band of Friends (Rory Gallagher's band) and in Australia with Stevie Wright (The Easybeats) and Jim Keays (Masters Apprentices). Ashton has recorded with members of Robert Plant's and Rory Gallagher's bands and members of Deep Purple and Whitesnake. He has shared stages with Ray Charles, Van Morrison, Hubert Sumlin, Johnny Winter, Junior Wells, Rory Gallagher, BB King, Buddy Guy, Mick Taylor, Status Quo, The Yardbirds, Slade, The Troggs and many more, through over 30 countries.
